RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF ACT 537 PLAN

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, known as the “Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act,” as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and

WHEREAS, CEDARVILLE Engineering Group, LLC has prepared a Act 537 Plan which provides for sewage facilities in Newlin Township, and

WHEREAS, the 537 Plan provides for an individual and community on-lot management program that includes an educational component for homeowners, and

WHEREAS, the 537 Plan provides for a Sewage Management Program that includes pumping of on-lot systems at least once within a three year period, and


WHEREAS, Newlin Township finds that the Act 537 Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.


WHEREAS, Newlin Township has received comments from the Chester County Planning Commission, Chester County Health Department, and Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, and has responded to comments by adoption of letters provided by the Township’s consulting engineer to the various commenting entities.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of the Township of Newlin, Chester County, hereby adopts and submits to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as the “Official Plan” of the municipality, the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said Plan as required by law to the extent other municipalities and private entities mentioned in the 537 Plan move forward with implementation. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended.)
