RESOLUTION No. 2025-06**

**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS
FOR NEWLIN TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Newlin Township is responsible under the Second Class Township Code for the public safety of the residents of Newlin Township;

WHEREAS, at the request of the Chester County Board of Commissioners, Newlin Township has previously adopted a resolution outlining the methods and agencies chosen to fulfill the public safety needs of the Township for the efficient administration of the integrated emergency communications system of the Chester County Department of Emergency Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that Longwood Fire Co., West Bradford Fire Co. and Modena Fire Co. are designated as the first-call responders for fire protection and shall each cover the geographic boundaries depicted on the map titled "Newlin Township Fire Territory" which is attached hereto. Second-due responders will be dispatched via Automatic Vehicle Locator;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Longwood Ambulance, Modena Fire Co. and Good Fellowship Ambulance & EMS Training Institute ("Good Fellowship") are designated as the responders to provide basic life support (BLS) ambulance services and shall each cover the geographic boundaries depicted on the map titled "Newlin Township BLS Territory" which is attached hereto

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Longwood Ambulance and Good Fellowship are designated as the responders to provide advanced life support (ALS) ambulance services and shall each cover the geographic boundaries depicted on the map titled "Newlin Township ALS Territory" which is attached hereto;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the PA State Police - Embreeville will provide full-time police protection;


FURTHER RESOLVED, that Richard Hicks is designated as the Newlin Township Emergency Management Coordinator; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors has heretofore adopted the Newlin Township Emergency Operations Plan dated September 11, 2023 and has reviewed and adopted the National Incident Management System as a common operating practice;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Newlin Township contact person(s) for said organizations and the Chester County Department of Emergency Services shall be Richard Hicks.



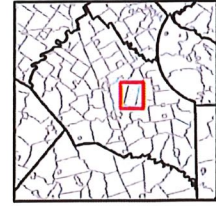

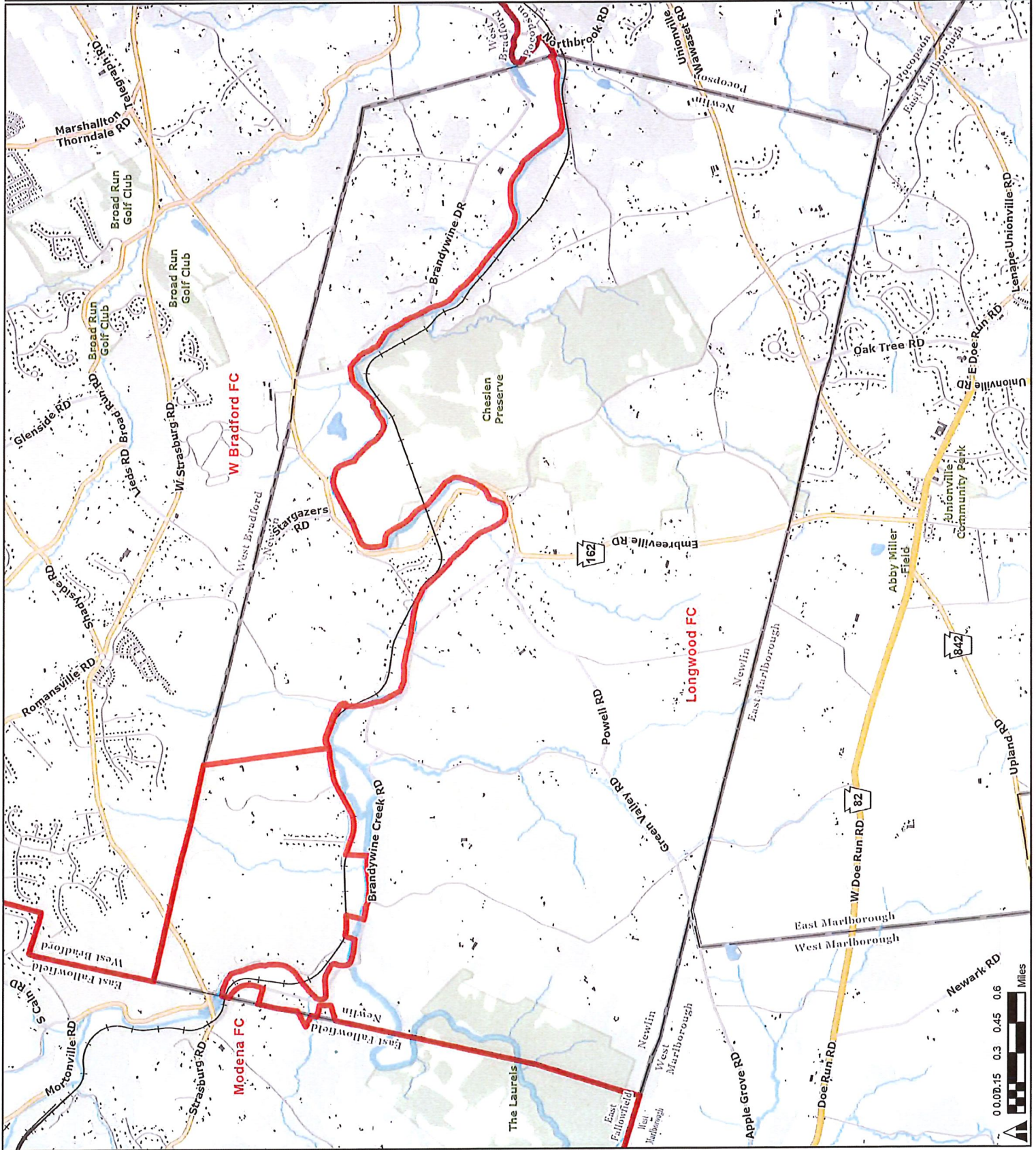

NEWLIN TOWNSHIP Fire Territory

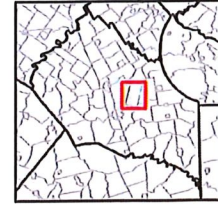
 Fire Territory



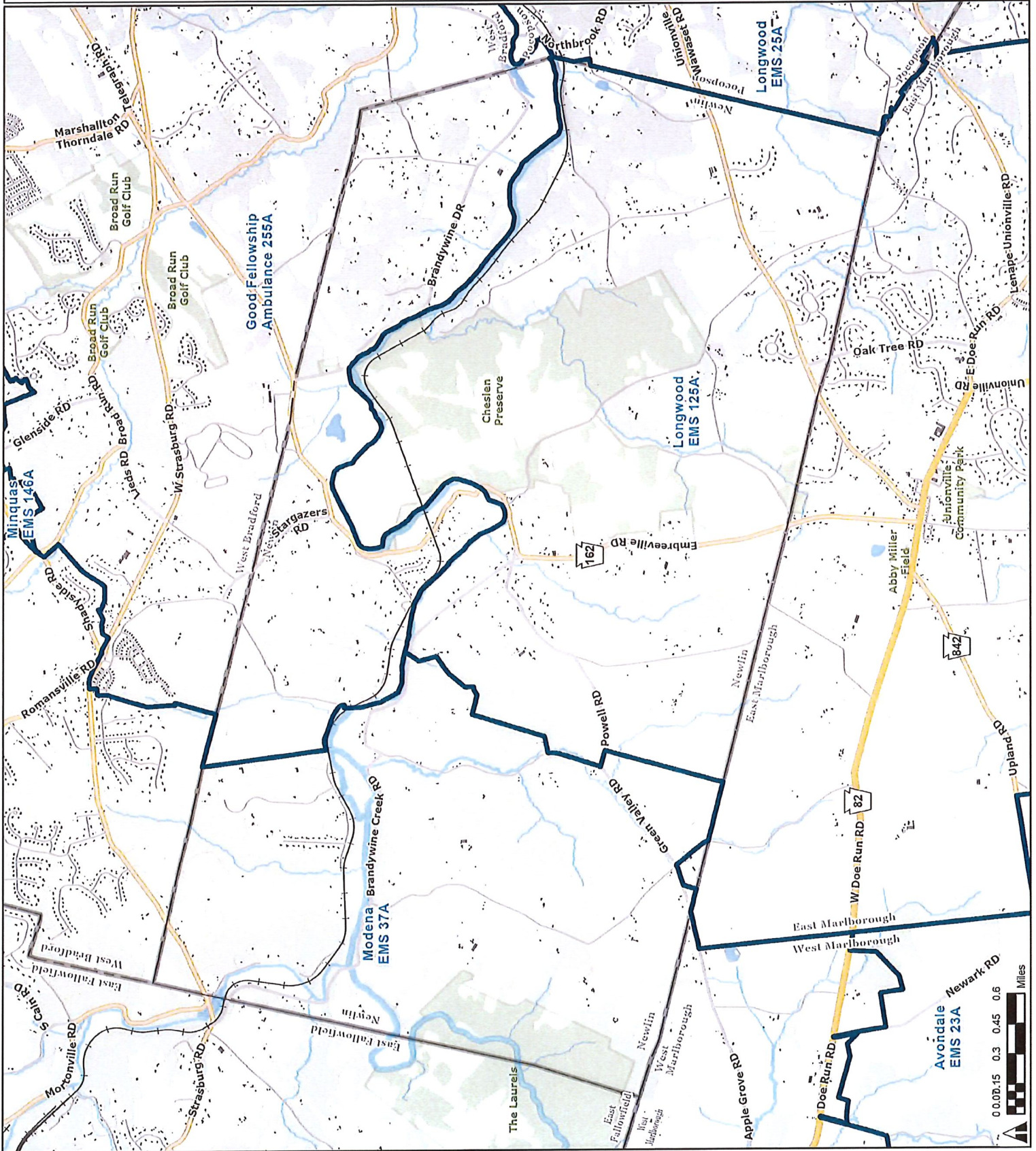

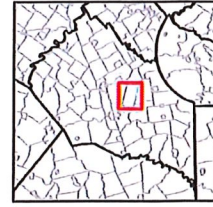
NEWLIN TOWNSHIP BLS Territory
